



COURSE OBJECTIVES

At the end of the MBBS course students shall: 1. Acquire knowledge and understanding of

- the sciences upon which medicine depends and the scientific and experimental methods.
- the structure, function and normal growth and development of the human body and the workings of the mind and their interaction, the factors which may disturb these, and the disorders of structure and function which may result.
- the etiology, natural history and prognosis of the common mental and physical ailments. Students must have experience of emergencies and a good knowledge of the common diseases of the community and of ageing processes.
- normal pregnancy and childbirth, the common obstetric emergencies, the principles of ante-natal and post natal care, and medical aspects of family planning and psychosexual counseling.
- the principles of prevention and of therapy, including health education, the amelioration of suffering and disability, rehabilitation, the maintenance of health in old age, and the care of the dying.
- human relationships, both personal and social and the interaction between man and his physical, biological and social environment.
- the organization and provision of health care in the community and in hospital, the identification of the need for it, and the economic, ethical and practical constraints within which it operates, and
- the ethical standards and legal responsibilities of the medical profession.















MBBS COURSE OBJECTIVES

2. Develop the professional skills necessary to -

- elicit, record and interpret the relevant medical history, symptoms and physical signs, and to identify the problems and how these may be managed.
- carry out simple practical clinical procedures.
- deal with common medical emergencies.
- communicate effectively and sensitively with patients and their relatives.
- communicate clinical information accurately and concisely, both by word of mouth and in writing, to medical colleagues and to other professionals involved in the care of the patient.
- use laboratory and other diagnostic and therapeutic services effectively and economically, and in the best interests of his patients.

3. Develop appropriate attitudes to the practice of medicine, which include -

- recognition that a blend of scientific and humanitarian approaches is needed in medicine.
- a capacity for self-education, so that he may continue to develop and extend his knowledge and skills throughout his professional life, and recognize his obligation to contribute if he can to the progress of medicine and to new knowledge.
- the ability to assess the reliability of evidence and the relevance of scientific knowledge, to reach conclusions by logical deduction or by experiment, and to evaluate critically methods and standards of medical practice. a continuing concern for the interests and dignity of his patients.
- an ability to appreciate the limitations of his own knowledge, combined with a willingness, when necessary, to seek further help, and
- the achievement of good working relationships with members of the other health care professions.

MBBS COURSE OUTCOMES

1. Name of the course

Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS)

2. Basic qualifications & prerequisite for MBBS course

- HSC or equivalent with Science (Biology, Physics, Chemistry).
- Candidate has to secure required grade point in the SSC and HSC examinations.
- Candidate has to secure required grade point in the MBBS admission exam.

3. Student selection procedure for MBBS course

As per approval by the DCIMC admission committee, selection will be made -

- According to the MBBS admission test merit list.
- 5% of total students will be selected based on poor and meritorious quota/freedom fighter quota.

Foreign students need to apply according to the rules & regulation of their respective countries through their Embassies. NB: All academic activities including professional examination of each phase must completed within the specified time of the phase

Pass mark is 60% in each written, oral & practical/clinical exam separately

Marks and pattern of questions in written examination in each subject are distributed as, 10% of the marks of written examination of each paper of each subject is allocated for formative assessment, 20% is allocated for MCQ and 70% for SAQ (Except in Com. Medicine). There are separate answer scripts for MCQ examinations. There are twenty MCQ questions for each written paper. Each question has got five items, Time allocation is 30 minutes for 20 MCQ questions, and two & half hours for the SAQ questions.
















ACADEMIC FACILITIES



ADMISSION & APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Admission

Admission will be on the basis of merit following the terms and conditions as directed by the Govt. of the People's Republic Bangladesh. At present the admission process will continue as per latest government decision for the session 2019-2020.

Those who have passed 'O' and 'A' level or equivalent examinations in the specified years having equivalent examination in the specified years having equivalent marks also eligible to apply with an equivalence certificate from Director General of Health Service, Mohakhali, Dhaka.

Application Procedure

Application form, prospectus and other information are available at the office of Dhaka Central International Medical College and Hospital.

Completed application form and relevant documents must be submitted to the office by the candidate or his/her representative in person within the announced date and time.

Document to be attached

For admission in MBBS course, the students need to apply in prescribed form which can be collected from the principal's office. The completed form, along with the documents is to be submitted on or before the date as declared in advertisement.

- 1. Attested photocopies of the transcripts of SSC and HSC or equivalent Examination.
- 2. Attested photocopies of the certificate/testimonial of SSC and HSC or equivalent examination.
- 3. Four copies of recent passport size attested photographs.
- 4. Nationality certificate from Chairman of the Union Parishad / Ward Commissioner of Metropolitan City or National ID Card.
- 5. Money receipt of the purchased admission form
- 6. Admission form must be completed properly
- 7. Admit card from DG Health
- 8. Merit Score and Position of the exam taken by DG Health
- 9. Parents/Guardian Financial Solvency Certificate
- 10. Foreign students also admitted to DCIMC according to the instruction of MOH&FW of Bangladesh.

Fitness Test

The selected candidate will be examined by a medical board for their physical fitness. The medical board will be formed by the Principal of Medical College.

Admission in DCIMC

Director General of Health Service (DGHS), Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh conducts a central written admission test at the national level for admission in the government and non-government medical colleges each year. They publish a merit list for eligible candidates. The authority of medical college selects the students according to the merit list from the students who applied for admission in DCIMC.

Conduct & Discipline

All students are required to abide, by the rules and regulations of the college. Non-adherence to this rules and regulations will make the students liable for disciplinary action, which may range from warning to expulsion from the college. Student of Dhaka Central International Medical College are forbidden to organize Union, Association or society, other than those approved by the authority, in order to enrich their physical, intellectual, social and ethical development.

LEGAL CLAUSE FEES & EXPENSES

Undertaking in form of Bond

During admission into the college, the candidates and their parents or quardians are required to sign a bond on non-judicial stamp regarding the terms and conditions of study conduct and discipline. Admission formality will be incomplete without submission of the bond.

Tution & Incidental Fees

Admission fees payable at the time of admission will be notified in suitable time. All payments are to be made in full at the time of admission. All payments made at the of Admission are non-refundable.

- Tuition fee is payable on monthly basis within the first week of each month.
- Failure of payment on the due date will result in a fine on a daily basis.
- If monthly fees are delayed more than on month students name will be removed from the attendance registrar.
- The name of the student will be removed from the college registrar if tuition fees are not paid for 3 months consequently. In such case the students has to pay readmission fee to get re-enrolment.
- Tuition fees will have to be cleared before each profession al examination.
- The rates are however subject to change asa required.
- Internship Fee is not included in the course fee. If any students wants to complete internship from DCIMC, student have to pay the internship fees as per private medical college intern payment rules that is declared by MOH&FW Bangladesh.

IN COURSE EXAMINATION & **INTERNSHIP**

DHAKA CENTRAL INTERNATIONAL MEDICAL COLLEGE

In Course Examination

Regular study and following the classes are indispensable for passing through the vast curriculum of the MBBS course. To conform to the need of the course and achieving high standard regular periodic class tests, assignments, item, card final and term final examinations are conducted by each department. The card final and term final examinations try to mimic the University conducted professional examinations (discussed below).

10% of the marks of the written examination of each subject in the professional examinations are allocated to the scores obtained from in course evaluations and class attendants. Only those students, who would acquire at least 60% marks in the course evaluations and attend a minimum 75% of the classes, are allowed to sit in the professional examinations.

Internship Training

Students who successfully pass through the final professional MBBS Examinations are required to undergo one year compulsory Internship Training in a BM&DC recognized hospital which of course include Dhaka Central International Medical College. It is prerequisite for each medical graduate to be a BM&DC recognized registered doctor and thus achieving the legal status of providing health care service and prescribe medicine.

Dhaka Central International Medical College has developed the full facility to design a fully structured and supervised training to develop the necessary skills and attitudes to deal with common health problems, to work in any hospital and community environment. The trainees are also entitled an appropriate subsistence allowance/ honorarium during the Internship. An Internship certificate mentioning the performance is issued by the hospital and academic authority.















INSTRUCTION FOR THE STUDENTS

Admitted students are to observe the following rules and regulations

- The students are expected to maintain the highest standard in their academic activities.
- Every student must have for himself/herself all the prescribed text books, dissecting instruments, medical equipment etc. The college will not supply these to the students.
- All students are to carry their "Identity Card" while they are in the college.
- All students are to attend the classes with clean dress.
- While in the college they should wear white apron, with their name plates on the left front side of the apron.
- Fashionable dresses, untidy hair, slippers are not allowed in the college campus.
- Rings, bangles are not allowed as they cause impediments to practical work.
- Students may inform their problems / grievances / inconveniences to the teacher guide. The guide will try to solve the problems of the students or refer them to the principal.
- Statements of the problems / grievances / inconveniences by the students must be in an orderly and disciplined manner. Any act of indiscipline on the part of any student including usage of abusive words or objectionable words and sentences, will make the students liable to punishment by expulsion from the college.
- All types of demonstrations, processions, shouting in the college and hospital premises are prohibited and students, who involve are liable to be expelled from the college.
- Political activities are not permitted in the college.
- Any verbal or physical violence is liable to disciplinary action.
- Smoking, alcoholism, narcotic drugs are strictly prohibited in the college and hospital campus.
- Environment is to be kept clean.

INSTRUCTION FOR THE STUDENTS

Admitted students are to observe the following rules and regulations


- Students should throw litters only to the waste paper baskets.
- Pasting of posters on the walls of the college and the hospital buildings and or hanging of posters in the college and in the hospital premises are prohibited. These are considered as acts of indiscipline and offenders are liable to punishment.
- Closing of college and hospital gates, doors of the college, or the hospital departments or creating obstacles to the normal functions of the college and/or hospital are acts of gross indiscipline and students involved in such liable to be excelled from the college.
- Students must not misbehave with the staffs or employees of the college or the hospital.
- Acts of misbehavior are also the acts of indiscipline and are liable to punishment.
- A student has to continue paying his/her tuition fees and session fees till he/she passes final professional examination.
- Absence from classes individually or in group or in a mass without prior information / without valid reasons are punishable by imposition of Tk. 100 / fine for each class individually. Guardian will be informed for such acts.
- Students are allowed to use library. They will seat and read. Books will be issued to the students for reading in the library or home, depending on availability.
- Cost or loss or damage to college / hospital property is liable to be realized from the student found responsible for the loss or damage.
- In case of illness or other unavoidable reasons for nonattendance, a written statement from the parent/guardian is to be presented to the teachers concerned, who in turn would submit it to the principal for approval.
- All students who have successfully qualified their MBBS degree are to undergo one year internship training (Hospital Training) as per rules and regulations of BM&DC (Bangladesh Medical & Dental Council).
- At the time of admission into the college the students and parents / Guardian will have to sign a bond that their children will abide by the rules and regulations of the college.






